What do we need to bring?

- Clipboards

Activity

- Work in pairs to devise instructions for a trail navigating obstacles in the Woodland Play area.
- You could also use some of the branches in the den building zone to create your own obstacle courses!
- Include directional language, verbs and prepositions in your instructions e.g. walk 10 paces, turn to your left, duck under the branch.
- Swap your trail with another group to test out how good your instructions are. They are only allowed to complete the actions that you have given them. Are you a clear and accurate communicator?
- As an extension for older or more confident groups try using a blindfold to make the trail even more challenging.
